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Core Prompt Engineering Principles

1. Be Specific About Business Context

Poor: "Tell me about supply chain issues"

Good: "Analyze current semiconductor supply chain disruptions affecting automotive manufacturers in Q4 2024. Focus on: lead time changes, alternative suppliers, and price impacts."

2. Request Structured Outputs

Poor: "Find information about our competitors"

Good: "Compare the following ERP vendors on these criteria: Latest product releases (last 6 months), Pricing models, Customer satisfaction trends, Market share changes. Format as a comparison table with sources."

3. Specify Time Sensitivity

Poor: "What's the stock price of NVDA?"

Good: "What is NVIDIA's current stock price and what were the 3 most significant market-moving news items in the past 48 hours?"

4. Define Quality Criteria

Poor: "Find news about AI regulations"

Good: "Summarize AI regulatory developments in the EU and US from the past 30 days. Prioritize official government sources and major legal publications. Exclude opinion pieces."

Successive Prompting Strategies

The power of Perplexity comes from chaining prompts to progressively refine and deepen analysis.

The Funnel Approach

Start broad, then progressively narrow based on initial findings.

Step 1: Discovery

What are the major developments in [industry] over the past quarter?

Step 2: Validation

You mentioned [specific development]. What are the primary sources reporting this, and what do industry analysts say about its impact?

Step 3: Deep Dive

For [specific aspect], provide: technical details, implementation timeline, cost implications, and competing approaches.

Step 4: Synthesis

Summarize the business implications in 3 bullet points with recommended next actions.

The Comparison Chain

Build comprehensive competitive analysis through layered queries.

Step 1: Market Landscape

List the top 5 providers in [category] with their market positioning.

Step 2: Feature Analysis

For [Provider 1] and [Provider 2], compare their offerings on: [specific criteria]

- Level 4 - Metric-Specific:** "What are the documented time savings and diagnostic accuracy improvements from AI-assisted radiology in 2024?"
- Level 5 - Decision-Ready:** "For hospitals implementing AI-assisted radiology in 2024: Average ROI timeline, Upfront and ongoing costs, Staff training requirements, Integration complexity with existing PACS, Patient outcome improvements with citations"

Best Practices & Common Pitfalls

Error Handling

If results are too vague:

The information was too general. Please search specifically for: [List specific data points]
Use sources dated within the past [timeframe].

If results lack citations:

For each claim in your previous response, provide: Direct quote from source,
Source URL, Publication date, Author or organization

If results are outdated:

The sources provided are from [older date]. Please search again restricting
results to the past [shorter timeframe].

Building Confidence Through Verification

Multi-Source Confirmation:

Find 3 independent sources that confirm or refute: [statement/claim]

Common Pitfalls to Avoid

❌ **Too Vague:** "Tell me about the market" ✅ **Specific:** "Analyze the enterprise cloud storage market: top 3 vendors, growth rate, key differentiators, recent M&A activity"

❌ **No Time Bounds:** "Find news about company X" ✅ **Time-Bound:** "Find significant news about company X from the past 14 days, excluding routine earnings coverage"

❌ **Asking for Opinions:** "Is vendor X better than vendor Y?" ✅ **Asking for Data:** "Compare vendor X and Y on: feature set, pricing, customer satisfaction ratings, analyst reviews"

❌ **Single Massive Query:** "Tell me everything about AI in healthcare..." ✅ **Structured Sequence:** Query 1: Market overview, Query 2: Deep dive on top use case, Query 3: Regulatory landscape

❌ **Ignoring Source Quality:** "Find any information about X" ✅ **Specifying Sources:** "Find information about X from: peer-reviewed studies, industry reports from Gartner/Forrester, or official company disclosures"

Before Sending a Prompt - Checklist

- ☐ Defined specific timeframe (if relevant)
- ☐ Specified desired output format
- ☐ Identified quality criteria for sources
- ☐ Included relevant business context
- ☐ Made success criteria clear

After Receiving Results - Checklist

- ☐ Citations provided and credible
 - ☐ Information is current enough
 - ☐ Output format matches needs
 - ☐ Key questions answered
 - ☐ Need for follow-up clarification identified
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Advanced Patterns

Executive Briefing Pattern

Analyze [situation/topic] for executive review:
SITUATION: (2-3 sentences), KEY DEVELOPMENTS: (3 bullets),
BUSINESS IMPACT: (Quantified), RECOMMENDED ACTION: (Specific next steps)
Under 200 words with inline citations.

Scenario Planning Pattern

For [business situation], develop 3 scenarios:
OPTIMISTIC: Key assumptions, Timeline, Business implications
BASELINE: Most likely developments, Timeline, Business implications
PESSIMISTIC: Risk factors, Timeline, Business implications
Base on recent analyst predictions.
